

## **Manager of Measurement and Crude Quality**

The Manager of Measurement and Crude Quality will be responsible for the overall oversight and accountability of measurement and quality for crude oil as well as measurement for refined products. The Manager will also be responsible for the oversight of Company measurement standards, policy, procedures and training.

The successful candidate will be an independent, highly motivated, with experience working in a fast moving environment. They will exhibit a positive attitude and exercise good judgment and discretion with internal and external contacts and confidential matters. They will be goal orientated; proficient in prioritizing tasks, possess the ability to think strategically, exhibit strong project and time management skills, and possess excellent verbal and written presentation skills.

This position will report directly to the Manager of Operations Support.

### **Responsibilities:**

The responsibilities of the Manager of Measurement and Quality include but are not limited to the following:

- Drive consistency and increase accuracy of measurement processes and volumetric accounting practices across all Divisions
- Work with Operations, Engineering & Scheduling to ensure measurement policy compliance
- Monitor industry trends and preferences as they relate to measurement and quality and participate in applicable API and/or ASTM working groups (i.e. 10.4 Field Centrifuge Working Group)
- Communicate needs, problems, and assist in the development of solutions

### **Activities/Tasks:**

- Evaluate loss/gain performance and provide guidance for correcting any findings.
- Communicate with third party customers any discrepancies found. Determine why the discrepancy occurred (and resolve discrepancies in a professional manner) and whose number is correct for use on ticket
- Scope and prioritize measurement projects in conjunction with Operations, Commercial, Engineering, and other internal stakeholders. Assist in development of capital and major maintenance budgets
- Continue to develop training programs and provide technical support for field personnel
- Communicate with customers, suppliers, and employees regarding measurement activities

### **Qualifications:**

- Excellent verbal and written communications skills

- Minimum 5 years prior experience in measurement
- Excellent computer skills with a proficiency in Excel
- Ability to work independently in a fast paced work environment
- Attention to detail with strong analytical skills
