Essential functions/duties:

Under the general direction of the Pipeline Integrity Manager, the incumbent will:

- Schedule Inspection events, including “smart pigs” and hydrostatic testing of pipelines
- Coordinate all events surrounding the smart pig inspection or testing of pipelines for Integrity Management purposes
- Provide input to the Integrity Management Plan (IMP) and assist in its maintenance
- Analyze test/inspection results and develop repair or evaluation plans to facilitate timely repair or evaluation
- Analyze smart pig inspection results and prepare statistical analysis of findings
- Analyze pipeline defects using currently available formulas and methodologies
- Document activities pertinent to all of the above

Required skills, abilities and experience:

- Demonstrated understanding of corrosion mechanisms and prevention measures
- Fluent in use of Microsoft Excel, Word and PowerPoint.
- Demonstrated well-developed communications skills (verbal & written) as well as technical writing skills.
- Effectively communicate and interact internally at levels from executive to field teams.
- Possess strong technical, organizational and analytical skills.
- Educational requirements include a BS in Engineering (Civil or Mechanical preferred). Other degrees may be considered if enhanced by appropriate work experience.
- A minimum of 5 years pipeline industry experience is required and candidate will have demonstrated experience in leadership and management and possess excellent analytical skills and strong technical skills.
