A Transfer Charge of **[D]** 11.25 cents per barrel of 42 U.S. gallons will be in effect for the transfer of Crude Petroleum into and out of Carrier's terminal at Colorado City, Scurry County, Texas.

CONTRACT TERMS:

The contract rate set forth in this tariff applies to shipments of any Shipper contracting for transportation of a minimum guaranteed volume of 20,000 barrels per day during the initial Contract Term of 90 consecutive days. In addition to the quality specifications set forth in Item No. 25 of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s F.E.R.C. No. 2, supplements thereto and reissues thereof, the following shall apply: shipments shall have a maximum of 0.28% Sulfur, by weight, with a gravity of 38 – 45 degrees API.
