PROPORTIONAL TARIFF

The charge named in this tariff is for receipt of Crude Petroleum by Plains Pipeline, L.P. in the Wood River Area of Madison County, Illinois, and the transfer of such Crude Petroleum to other connected facilities in the area of Wood River, Madison County, Illinois.

The charge is **[D]** 7.55 cents per barrel of 42 U.S. gallons each

Governed, except as otherwise provided herein, by rules and regulations published in Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s F.E.R.C. No. 2, supplements thereto or reissues thereof.

EXCEPTIONS TO PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P.'S F.E.R.C. NO. 2:

ITEM NO. 25: In addition to the provisions stated in Item No. 25(a) of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following rule will apply to this tariff: No Crude Petroleum will be accepted for transportation except Crude Petroleum of the gravity of twenty degrees (20°) A.P.I. (American Petroleum Institute) or higher.

ITEM NO. 70: In lieu of the provisions stated in Item No. 70(d) of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following rule will apply to this tariff: no loss allowance.
