NOTE: The rates quoted above include any necessary working storage at the Ten Mile Terminal, as well as at Liberty, Lumberton, Eucutta and Purvis, Mississippi. As stated below in the exceptions to Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s F.E.R.C. No. 2, Shippers may lease long term storage at the Ten Mile Terminal for 30.59 cents per Barrel of Crude Petroleum per calendar month.

GATHERING: No gathering service will be performed under this tariff, and the rates named herein are for trunkline transportation only.

PUMPING CHARGE: For delivery on board tank cars or delivery to customer's tanks where additional pumping service is necessary to make delivery, an additional charge of 6.97 cents per Barrel will be made.

NOTE (1) A contract rate from Mobile, Mobile County, Alabama to Delhi, Richland County, Louisiana is available to all shippers signing a Throughput Agreement for the transportation of a minimum annual volume of 3,650,000 barrels of crude petroleum. Please see Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s F.E.R.C. No. 8, supplements thereto or reissues thereof, for the applicable contract tariff rate.

EXCEPTIONS AND ADDITIONS TO PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P. ("PLAINS") F.E.R.C. NO. 2:

ITEM NO. 25: In lieu of certain of the provisions stated in Item No. 25(a) of Plains's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following will apply to movements listed herein:

Carrier reserves the right to reject any and all Crude Petroleum having a vapor pressure of 11.0 pounds per square inch absolute or greater under actual storage conditions, a gravity of less than eighteen degrees (18°) API or a viscosity of more than 350 SSU at one hundred degrees (100°) Fahrenheit.

ITEM NO. 60: In addition to the provisions stated in Item No. 60 of Plains's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following will apply to movements listed herein:

Carrier owns and operates facilities necessary for receiving Crude Petroleum at Liberty, Lumberton, Eucutta and Purvis, Mississippi and Ten Mile, Alabama. At all other destination points, Plains will receive Crude Petroleum for transportation only when the Shipper or Consignee has provided the necessary facilities for receiving said crude petroleum promptly on arrival at said destination, as provided for in Item No. 60, Receipt and Destination Facilities Required, of Plains's tariff F.E.R.C. No. 2.

ITEM NO. 70: In lieu of the provisions stated in Item No. 70(d) of Plains's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following will apply to movements listed herein:

*The applicable loss allowance stated in Item No. 70(d) of Plains's tariff F.E.R.C. No. 2 will apply to all movements listed above that are marked with asterisks (**); for all other movements listed above, the following loss allowance will apply: no loss allowance.*

ITEM NO. 125: In addition to the provisions stated in Item No. 125 of Plains's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following will apply to movements listed herein:

Shippers may lease long term storage at the Ten Mile Terminal for [D] 30.59 cents per Barrel of Crude Petroleum per calendar month.
