EXCEPTIONS AND ADDITIONS TO PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P.'s. SUPPLEMENT NO. 1 to F.E.R.C. NO. 2, RULES AND REGULATIONS:

ITEM NO. 25: In addition to the provisions stated in paragraph (a) of Item No. 25 of Plains's Rules and Regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following will apply to movements listed herein:

Carrier will only accept for transportation Crude Petroleum with gravity of twenty six (26) degrees A.P.I. or higher.

ITEM NO. 70: In lieu of the provisions stated in paragraph (d) of Item No. 70 of Plains's Rules and Regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, the following will apply to movements listed herein:

A deduction will be made on a prorata basis among shippers to cover the actual losses of crude petroleum due to evaporation and loss during transportation.
