**GAUGING, LOADING AND UNLOADING CHARGES**

In connection with trunk line movement of Crude Petroleum, for gauging, testing, loading into trucks in the field, and gauging, testing and unloading from trucks at pipeline stations (28.10) cents per barrel of 42 U.S. Gallons will be assessed.

**CHARGE FOR THE RECEIPTS FROM OTHERS' TRUCK UNLOADING FACILITIES**

Pursuant to Item No. 95 of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, supplements thereto and reissues thereof, the following charges will apply:

A charge of seven and eleven hundredths (7.02) cents per barrel will be assessed on receipts from the Truck unloading facilities of others at Wink Station East, Judkins Station, Keystone Station, Monahans Station, Sand Hill Station, and Crane Station.

A charge of two and eighty-three hundredths (2.79) cents per barrel will be assessed on receipts from the Truck unloading facilities of others at Crane Station.

A charge of seven and six hundredths (6.97) cents per barrel will be assessed on receipts from the Truck unloading facilities of others at Goldsmith Station.

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**PUMPING CHARGE/DELIVERY CHARGES**

A charge of seven and eleven hundredths (7.02) cents per barrel will be assessed for deliveries from Wink East Station to Chevron Pipe Line Company's Wink West Station.

A charge of seven and eleven hundredths (7.02) cents per barrel will be assessed for deliveries to or from Connecting pipelines at Midland, Texas.

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Future movements from Midland Station, Texas to Wink Station East, Texas may be made via Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s tariff Texas R.R.C. No. 156, supplements thereto or reissues thereof.

**EXCEPTIONS TO PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P.'S F.E.R.C. NO. 2**

In addition to the quality specifications stated in Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, supplements thereto and reissues thereof, the following quality specification will apply: sulphur content shall not exceed 0.4% for deliveries of Crude Petroleum into Midland Station.

In lieu of the provision stated in the second sentence of Item No. 80 of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s F.E.R.C. No. 2 supplements thereto and reissues thereof, quantities of Crude Petroleum for receiving and delivering will be Net Standard Volume. Net Standard Volume shall be defined for purposes of this tariff as Volume corrected to a temperature of sixty degrees (60°) Fahrenheit, in accordance with the latest API/ASTM measurement standards, and at equilibrium vapor pressure less deductions of impurities shown by tests made by Carrier prior to receipt and upon delivery.

In lieu of the provisions stated in Item No. 70 (d) of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 2, supplements thereto or reissues thereof, the following will apply: Receipts from Centurion Pipeline, L.P.'s Midland Station for delivery to Mesa Pipeline at Midland, Texas shall be subject to the following loss allowance: no loss allowance.
