Pumping Fee: An additional fee of [D] 2.88 cents per barrel will be assessed for pumping Shipper's crude oil from one tank to another in the Ft. Laramie, Wyoming Tank Farm.

- (1) **Contract Tariff Rates:** The following contract tariff rates are available for movements to Cheyenne, Wyoming to all Shippers signing a Throughput and Deficiency Agreement for the transportation of a minimum annual volume of 12,775,000 barrels of crude petroleum over a ten year term.

EXCEPTIONS AND ADDITIONS TO ROCKY MOUNTAIN PIPELINE LLC's F.E.R.C. NO. 135, SUPPLEMENTS THERETO OR REISSUES THEREOF.

ITEM NO. 30: In addition to the provisions stated in Item No. 30, Segregation and Variations in Quality and Gravity, of Rocky Mountain Pipeline LLC's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 135, supplements thereto or reissues thereof, the following will apply to movements listed herein: *no crude oil shall be accepted into the Ft. Laramie, Wyoming Tank Farm with a viscosity greater than 350 centistokes at pumping temperature, except crude oil delivered by truck.*

ITEM NO. 40: Instead of the provisions stated in ¶ (b) of Item No. 40, Gauging, Deductions and Adjustments, of Rocky Mountain Pipeline LLC's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 135, supplements thereto or reissues thereof, the following will apply to movements listed herein: *for crude petroleum moved to Cheyenne, WY under the Contract Tariff Rates, the loss allowance shall be actual losses, not to exceed two-tenths of one percent (0.20%).*

ITEM NO. 90: Instead of the provision stated in Item No. 90, Truck Unloading, of Rocky Mountain Pipeline LLC's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 135, supplements thereto or reissues thereof, the following will apply: *for crude petroleum moved under the Contract Tariff Rates noted above, a Truck Unloading Charge of [D] 16.61 cents per barrel will be made for Truck Unloading services at the Ft. Laramie Wyoming Tank Farm.*

ITEM NO. 100: Instead of the provision stated in Item No. 100, Gravity Bank Adjustments, of Rocky Mountain Pipeline LLC's rules and regulation tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 135, supplements thereto or reissues thereof, the following will apply to movements listed herein: *the gravity bank shall not apply.*
